
$$2 + 5 = 7$$

Little Bear has too many cakes for her birthday! She had two cakes and then her friends brought five more! How many cakes did she have in all?




$$4 + 3 = 7$$

Little Bear got four presents and then she got three more! How many presents did she get for her birthday?



$$3 + 3 = 6$$

There were three heart balloons for Little Bear and her friends gave her three more. How many heart balloons did she have in all?



$$2 + 2 = 4$$

Little Bear's best friend came with two round balloons and the twins brought two more. How many round balloons did she have in all?

$$5 + 4 = 9$$

Mama Bear baked cupcakes for the party. She decorated five for the party and four for the family. How many cupcakes did she bake?

$$4 + 4 = 8$$

Papa Bear made ice cream cones for four little bears. He made one for Little Bear, Mama Bear, Brother Bear and himself. How many cones did he make in all?

$$3 + 2 = 5$$

Three friends came to the party first and then two little bears surprised Little Bear! How many friends came to her party?

$$4 + 2 = 6$$

Little Bear made lemonade for the party. She only had four glasses and so she made two more. How many glasses of lemonade did she make?
