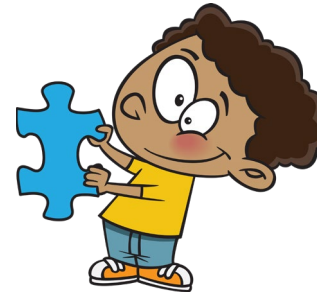

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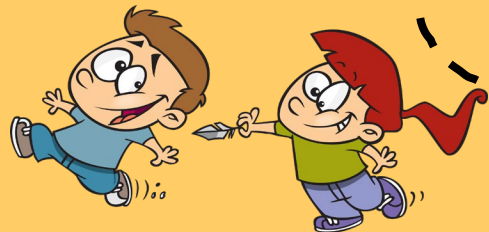
I could never eat this!

I gave a flower to my mother.



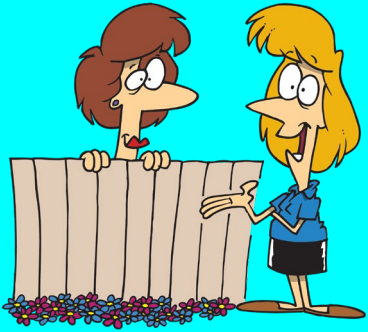

My father has a lot of ties!



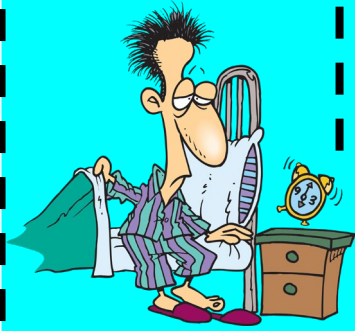
I always feed the birds.
