whenever I go out there, he takes a stab at me.

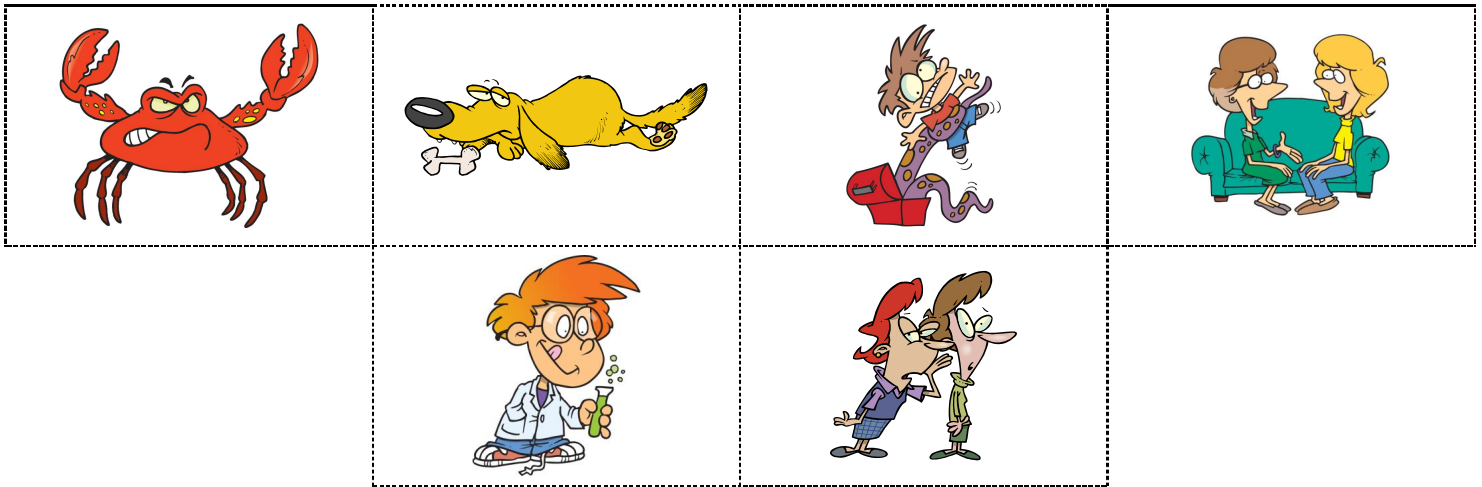
